



Fighting Inflation

- Froze the rate on vehicle property taxes for two years, saving approximately \$340 million for Kentuckians.
- Signed House Bill 1, further reducing the state individual income tax during a time of record tax collections.
- Supported legislation to cut the sales tax temporarily, which would have saved Kentuckians \$873 million had the General Assembly supported the measure.
- Joined a coalition of governors to urge Congressional leadership to suspend the federal gas tax and transfer general fund dollars in the Highway Trust Fund.
- Filed an emergency regulation that froze the state gas tax, preventing a 2-cents-per-gallon increase, putting an expected \$35.4 million back in the pockets of Kentuckians.
- Requested a waiver from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to remove a requirement that more costly reformulated fuel be sold in many urban areas.
- Declared a state of emergency and activated the state price-gouging law regarding gas prices.
