

Data Changes with End of National PHE

- **COVID-19 laboratory test reporting**
 - Positivity rates will no longer be possible in many instances
 - New case data and incidence rates will be less complete
 - Federal COVID-19 Community Level Map may change
- **COVID-19 hospitalization data frequency likely to decrease**
- **Later this year, KDPH will no longer have same access to quantities of therapeutics available, distributed or dispensed**

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Additional Implications of PHE Conclusion

- **COVID-19 surveillance will continue, possibly as part of a fall/winter respiratory process that includes COVID-19, influenza, and RSV**
- **kycovid19.ky.gov website will:**
 - be streamlined to reduce duplication
 - continue to provide educational information and relevant data
 - evolve as nation and fellow states further adapt
- **Dedicated COVID-19 hotline will end on May 12, 2023**



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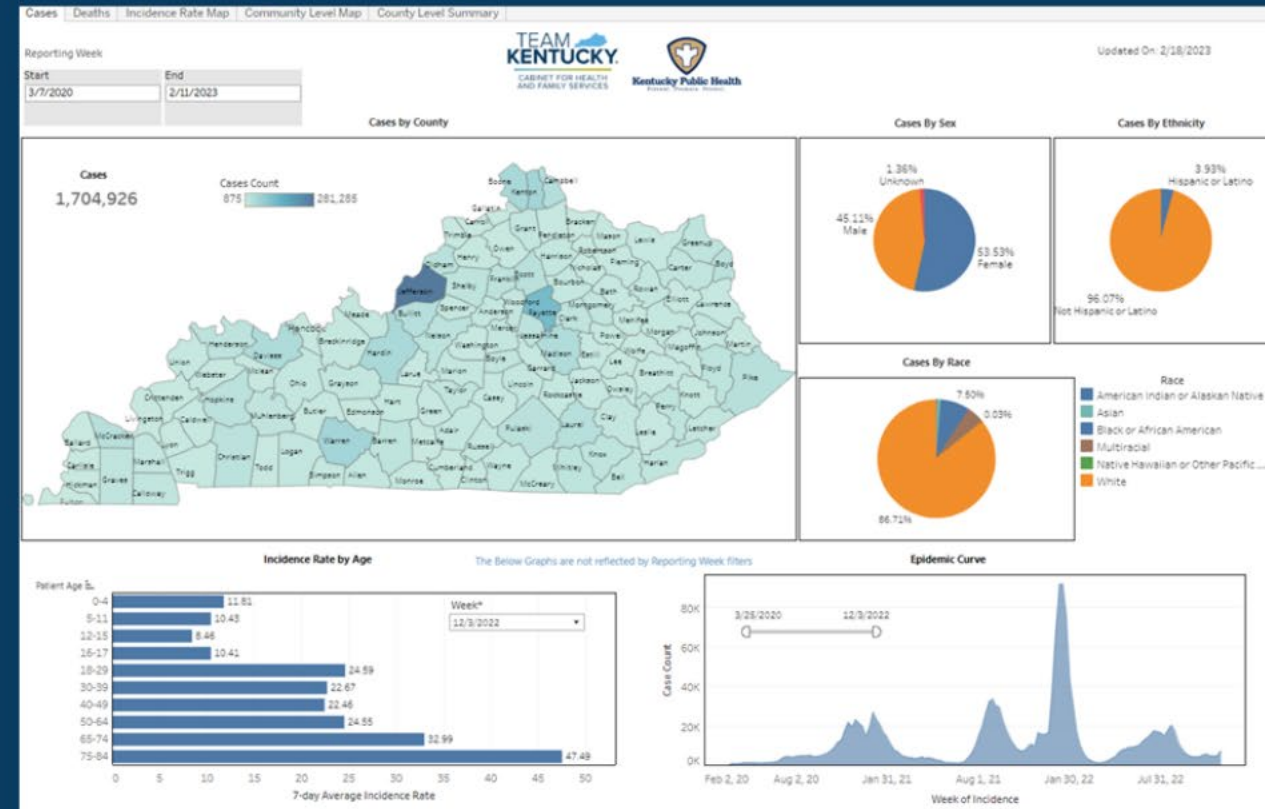
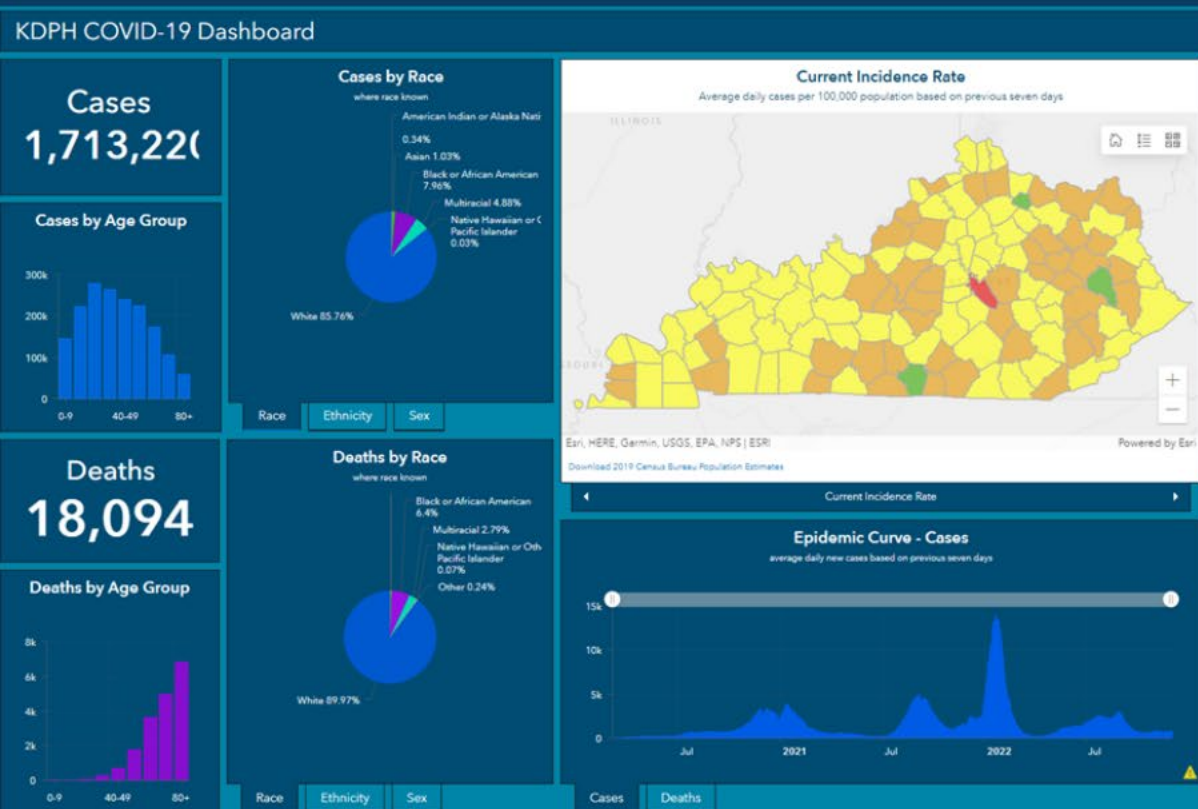
