Remnants of Helene Bringing Widespread Rain and Gusty Winds

Key Messages

- → Widespread moderate to heavy rain and windy conditions today
- → 3 to 5 inches of rain possible through Sunday night. Locally higher amounts possible
- → Wind gusts 40 to 55 mph likely today, mainly late morning into the afternoon. A few higher gusts possible, especially eastern KY/southern IN

Impacts


- → Minor flooding possible today with the arrival of tropical rains, with a slight risk for flash flooding with the most intense rainfall.
- → Weakly rooted trees could fall, and loose objects will be blown around.

Time of Arrival - 45+ MPH Winds

Some Gusts may exceed 60 MPH if clearing occurs

Key Messages

- → Widespread 45 to 55 MPH winds expected over a large part of the area
- → Locally higher gusts possible especially across eastern KY and northern KY
- → 35 to 45 MPH winds expected over southern and western KY
- Strength of winds somewhat dependent on clouds clearing and hurts confidence

Impacts


- Weakly rooted trees may fall, and objects may be blown around

Wind Headlines

High Wind Warning and Wind Advisory In Effect

Key Messages

- → Widespread 45 to 55 MPH winds expected over a large part of the area
- → Locally higher gusts possible especially across eastern KY and northern KY
- → 35 to 45 MPH winds expected over southern and western KY
- Strength of winds somewhat dependent on clouds clearing and hurts confidence

Impacts

- → Weakly rooted trees may fall, and objects may be blown around
- → Travel in high profile vehicles will be difficult especially on N-S roads.



Peak Wind Gusts

Key Messages

- → Peak wind gusts will mostly range in the 40 to 55 mph range, however some gusts over 60 MPH are possible from late morning through early evening
- → Stronger gusts most likely across eastern KY, north central KY, and southern IN

Impacts

- → Power outages possible
- → Weakly rooted trees may come down
- → Unsecured outdoor objects will be moved



Additional Rain Accumulations

Through Sunday Night

Key Messages
