



## **Selected Projects for the Recreational Trails Program (RTP)**

Below is a full list of projects selected by Gov. Andy Beshear to receive funding from the federal RTP Program. This is the first step in a process to send each project individually to the Federal Highway Administration for review. Once a project receives federal approval, funding will be released.

In total, \$1.4 million are planned to go to 8 projects in Kentucky.

### **1. City of Danville (Boyle County)**

- The city of Danville would use \$150,000 in funding from the RTP to help with the construction of a paved multi-use trail.

### **2. City of Olive Hill (Carter County)**

- The city of Olive Hill would use \$159,952 in funding from the RTP to help create 16 miles of multi-purpose trails, in phases.

### **3. Christian County Fiscal Court**

- The Christian County Fiscal Court would use \$117,463 in funding from the RTP to help the development of a mountain bike skills training park for Western Kentucky.

### **4. City of Madisonville (Hopkins County)**

- The city of Madisonville would use \$150,000 in funding from the RTP to help with the completion of the remaining 1.25 miles of trail at Madisonville City Park.

### **5. City of Earlington (Hopkins County)**

- The city of Earlington would use \$176,000 in funding from the RTP to help continue the development and improvement of trails and amenities at Loch Mary Lake ATV Park.

### **6. City of Beattyville (Lee County)**

- The city of Beattyville would use \$233,000 in funding from the RTP to help with the construction of a trailhead facility at Crystal Creek.

### **7. City of Camargo (Montgomery County)**

- The city of Camargo would use \$177,000 in funding from the RTP to help make trail improvements at the city park.

**8. Owsley County Fiscal Court**

- The Owsley County Fiscal Court would use \$250,000 in funding from the RTP to help design and construct a series of dirt trails specifically tailored for motor sport car testing.
