Increasing Potential for Severe Storms, Gusty Winds, and Locally Heavy Rainfall

Key Messages

- Strong non-thunderstorm winds are expected late \rightarrow Friday afternoon through Friday night

Wind Gusts in excess of 40 mph are *likely*, especially after midnight Friday night

- A line of strong to severe storms will move east across \rightarrow Kentucky and southern Indiana Friday night into early Saturday morning
 - Greatest severe risk over western Kentucky. Severe threat diminishes as storms move east early Saturday morning.

Primary Threats: Damaging Winds, Brief Tornadoes, Isolated Hail



Saturday Afternoon and Evening

Increasing Potential for Severe Storms, Gusty Winds, and Heavy Rainfall

Key Messages

Gusty non-thunderstorm winds are expected to \rightarrow continue into Saturday



Wind Gusts in excess of 40 mph are *likely*

Severe weather potential midday Saturday into the \rightarrow evening



- Severe weather threat for Saturday has increased
- Primary Threats: Damaging Winds, Large Hail, Isolated Tornadoes
- 1-3" of rain with locally higher amounts may lead to \rightarrow minor flooding






Excessive Rainfall Outlook

Multiple Waves of Rainfall Friday Night through Saturday Night

Key Messages

- Multiple waves of rainfall \rightarrow Friday night through Saturday night could bring *widespread* rainfall amounts of 1-3".
- A narrower swath of total \rightarrow rainfall amounts over 3" may develop by Saturday night.
- Heavy rainfall rates in \rightarrow thunderstorms will increase *flash flooding* potential Saturday afternoon and evening.
- 30-50% chance of minor \rightarrow flooding on the Green River downstream of Munfordville by early next week.

Outlook Meaning

Last Moderate was May 26, 2024 a very High impact event Previously was March 31, 2023 and event that was very high impact but largely spared the quad-state This was also the last Moderate issued two days in advance, which is quite uncommon Be alert - prepare to adjust plans accordingly

Level 4 of 5

MODERATE RISK

Widespread severe storms likely.


Long-lived and intense storms likely.
