St. Claire HealthCare – West Liberty

St. Claire HealthCare (SCH) is excited to announce plans for a more than \$11 million capital investment to expand access to high-quality healthcare for residents throughout the region. SCH will begin construction on a nearly 8,000 sq. ft. rural health clinic on West Main Street in West Liberty (Morgan County, KY) in early 2024.

This exciting new project was made possible thanks to the collaboration of healthcare professionals and leaders at the local, state, and federal levels, and the generosity of Jon Will Stacy and the Stacy Family whose donation of property for the clinic, valued at just over \$500,000, will make an impact on their community for generations to come.

St. Claire HealthCare is tremendously grateful for the leadership of Governor Andy Beshear and his team, and the support of Senator Mitch McConnell, Congressman Hal Rogers, State Representative Richard White, Morgan County Judge-Executive Jim Gazay and the entire Morgan County Fiscal Court, as well as, Tom Carew and the USDA team in bringing this project to life.

- When fully operational, the clinic will employ approximately 30 staff with an average annual wage of \$90,000.
- With 14 exam/procedure rooms, patients will have access to primary care services, a retail pharmacy, and a rotation of specialty practices. Cardiology, general surgery, OB/GYN, as well as, orthopaedics and sports medicine have all expressed interest in offering clinic days at the new location.
- The clinic will also include a retail pharmacy. This expansion of SCH's 340B pharmacy program will offer patients a convenient, cost-effective choice for their prescription medications.
- The clinic will serve as a new clinical rotation site to educate and train future healthcare professionals including residents and medical students, pharmacists, therapists, allied health professionals, and others.
- This project is funded, in part, by a USDA Emergency Rural Health Care Grant.
